



## GETTING TO JONAH'S

Jonah's is situated 45 minutes by car from Sydney CBD and offers a scenic drive which includes breathtaking views along the Northern Beaches Peninsula or through national park. Jonah's is accessible by bus (from Sydney CBD) and boat (from the Central Coast/Ettalong). Jonah's is also accessible by a memorable seaplane flight from Sydney. Please contact Jonah's to arrange this amazing seaplane experience or for assistance in arranging limousine bookings for your stay or if you are dining at the restaurant.



**From the City and Southern suburbs:** Via the Sydney Harbour Bridge or Sydney Harbour Tunnel head north and take the signs for Mosman/Manly following Military Road. Follow Military Road to Spit Junction veer left as the road becomes Spit Road. You will stay on this road for approx 45 min. It will become Manly Road, then Burnt Bridge Creek Deviation, then Condamine Street and then Pittwater Road. After approx 30 min you will come to Mona Vale.

At Mona Vale, Pittwater Road veers left, stay to the right as the road becomes Barrenjoey Road, following the signs to Palm Beach. Follow Barrenjoey Road for approx 12 min until you come to Surf Road, turn right into Surf Road. You will see a sign for Jonah's. Follow Surf Road and take the first left - Bynya Road. Jonah's is located approximately 500m up Bynya Road on the right hand side.

**From the Western Suburbs:** Via the M4 motorway take the Homebush Bay Drive exit heading to North Ryde and the Northern Beaches. Follow this road for approx 40 min, it will become Lane Cove Road then Mona Vale Road. When Mona Vale Road ends at Mona Vale, turn left and follow the signs to Palm Beach. Follow directions above from Mona Vale.

**From the Northern Suburbs:** Via the Pacific Highway head to Gordon. At Gordon follow the signs for Mona Vale Road. Follow Mona Vale road for approx 20 min. When Mona Vale Road ends at Mona Vale turn left and follow the signs to Palm Beach. Follow directions above from Mona Vale.

**Parking:** Unfortunately, Jonah's has limited off street parking available. Guests must park legally at all times. Guests that ignore designated no stopping or no parking signs, park too close to t-intersections, block neighbours driveways or any other illegal activity will be booked by the police and/or council rangers.
